George L. Wilson Award Evaluation Process

The process considers 5 categories for the evaluation of the nominees. Each category is rated on a scale of 0 (low) – 9 (high) points. Totals from all categories may be used to compare nominees. The 5 categories include:

1 Assertiveness/ Persistence in Promoting the Safe and Secure Transport of Dangerous Goods

Active promotion of the development or implementation of safe and secure regulations and industry standards for the transport of dangerous goods

2 Communication Promoting Dangerous Goods Regulations

Communication to agencies and industry through various media (letters/regulatory comments/proposals/requests, formal papers, information papers, presentations, webinars, training programs, etc.) promoting safe and secure regulations and industry standards for the transport of dangerous goods

3 Expertise in the Dangerous Good Profession

The depth and breadth of expertise in international, regional, national and modal regulations, across a range of products, amending regulations, and identifying emerging issues requiring the attention of industry and authorities.

4 Influence on the Dangerous Goods Profession

Influence and one or more significant positive contributions regarding the development or implementation of safe and secure regulations and industry standards for the transport of dangerous goods

5 Recognition by the Dangerous Goods Community

Recognition based on visible participation in the dangerous goods profession with one or more regulatory agencies, industry groups, associations or companies
